

TERMS OF REFERENCE

Post-16 Committee

- To ensure the Post-16 curriculum is broad and balanced, complies with legislation and provides a wide range of subjects, preparing pupils for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of later life in modern Britain;
- To review progress on a regular basis against the priorities of the Post-16 Development Plan;
- To review, analyse and report on progression, recruitment and retention between Key Stage 4 and 5 and in relation to assessment/achievement data in consultation with the headteachers and appropriate staff members;
- To use data available to help to understand trends, strengths and weaknesses and to support improvement;
- To monitor and evaluate pupil performance using comparative data and tracking systems;

Teaching School Alliance Committee

- To receive a termly report from the Teaching School Director and to monitor and review the action plan of the Teaching School Alliance against delivered outcomes.
- To discuss commissions against Alliance capacity and to monitor and evaluate impact of outreach work on partner schools
- To evaluate allocation of finance to Action Plan, income and expenditure.
