**Re: Year 9 GCSE Options Process**

This morning, we launched the Options Process with Year 9 students during an Information Assembly. Students received an overview of the process, the range of subjects to select from and the support available to all students.

All students study the core subjects of English Language, English Literature, Maths and Science. They will also attend lessons in Physical Education, Religious Education, Careers Education and Personal & Social Education. In addition, students will select five subjects, ranking them in order of preference, they wish study in Year 10 and Year 11. Students will be allocated four of the five subjects they select within their rank order.

In their ranked options, students must select **at least one subject** from Geography, History, French and Spanish.

The GCSE option subjects are listed below:

Geography	Fine Art	Hospitality & Catering
History	Photography	Health & Social Care
French	Textiles	Drama
Spanish	Sport	Music
Computer Science	Media	Business Studies

Students are encouraged to study a combination of GCSE subjects, including a language, that offer an important range of knowledge and skills to young people. Choosing both a humanity subject (Geography | History) and language subject (French | Spanish) at GCSE gives them access to a full range of employment options when they leave secondary school and the broad knowledge that employers are looking for. If they are thinking of going to university, this combination is also recommended by Britain's most prestigious universities.

On Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> January we will host the Year 9 Options Evening in School, 5:00 - 7:00pm, for all parents/carers and students. This is a very important evening which will include a Headteacher Presentation, Department Visits and a bookable 1:1 Appointment with an Options Advisor. The appointment will focus on a student's interests, current level of effort in their subjects, long-term ideas about careers and the way they like to learn.
